The landscape committee gave their presentation regarding the new landscape at the entrances to Wilderness Hills. The landscape committee was a 4 member committee that met 6 times as a group over a 5 month times spans and also spent many hours individually working on the ground work. Ben was also there to give us a demonstration of the lights that we are looking to add into the landscaping. Ted will be looking in to a few more questions regarding the new sign that is being changed at 27th street and Whispering Winds Blvd. The board gave a motion to approve the committee's proposal and it was passed. The next step will be the board meeting with Lincoln Federal to get the final approval of the project. The board will work to get the power point presentation added to the Wilderness Hills website.

- Dan has spoken with One 6 lawn service to repair the drain lines along Keystone.
- New business:

- A check for the amount of \$2325 was authorized to pay One 6 lawn service for the April mowing and fertilizing.
- The board was asked about paying for a couple of signs and ad for a
 neighborhood garage sale. There was a discussion about how this would impact
 the HOA as a whole and was unanimously passed to pay for the signs and the ad
 as long as Bethany, who brought up the idea, headed the details. The garage
 sale weekend will be June 1-3.
